→ Chapter 1 Getting Started

vjoon Content Activator is a plug-in for Adobe® InDesign® that allows you to activate the content of any secured frames contained in a layout. Whenever Adobe InDesign files are extracted from any kind of workflow system, e. g. exporting them from vjoon K4®, the frames are secured and cannot be edited. In case, you want external employees or service providers to edit these exported layouts, they can use this plug-in to activate any content for editing.



It is not possible to use vjoon Content Activator together with vjoon K4 plug-ins on the same computer. In this case, vjoon Content Activator is disabled.

System Requirements

Depending on the Adobe version you are using, the vjoon Content Activator version has to be used as follows. System requirements apply as for the corresponding software versions.

- vjoon Content Activator 1.18.x für Adobe InDesign 2025
- vjoon Content Activator 1.17.x für Adobe InDesign 2024
- vjoon Content Activator 1.16.x für Adobe InDesign 2023
- vjoon Content Activator 1.15.x für Adobe InDesign 2022
- vjoon Content Activator 1.14.x für Adobe InDesign 2021

Installation

(1)

Place the vjoon Content Activator plug-in in the folder "Plug-Ins" of Adobe InDesign.

(2)

Launch Adobe InDesign. If it is already running, quit the application and restart it.

You can now start to work with vjoon Content Activator as described in the next chapter.

About this manual

This manual assumes that you are familiar with macOS and the different Windows operating systems as well as Adobe InDesign. If this is not the case, please refer to the corresponding documentation.

→ Chapter 2 Using vjoon Content Activator

vjoon Content Activator allows you to activate content in layouts that have been exported from any workflow system. By default, any content in frames is secured and cannot be edited. Using this plug-in, you can change this setting simply by opening the exported layout with your Adobe InDesign application and applying the Content Activator command to the layout.



Please keep in mind, that it is not possible to use K4 plug-ins and vjoon Content Activator on the same computer. In this case, vjoon Content Activator is disabled. This plug-in is available in English language, only.

(1)

Open any layout file that has been exported from a vjoon K4 system using Adobe InDesign.

(2)

Select the command "Layout > Activate Content".

All frames within the layout are now unsecured, and you can start editing their content.
